Tools for Secondary Teachers Working with Students who Struggle at School and in the Classroom

How to best support a student who is struggling can be challenging. A wide variety of factors (which may include anxiety, depression or a trauma history) can influence why a young person is having difficulties and because of this young people vary in their responses to different interventions. Increasingly students may be school refusing.

This interactive full day workshop explores the different ways in which students may present in the classroom as well as current approaches for effectively managing these situations. Practical classroom strategies, change conversations and school wide approaches, are presented. A variety of resources are also provided. Participants are encouraged to bring case studies for small group discussions.
